### 1. What are cookies and similar tracking technologies?

#### (1) Cookies

Cookies are text files containing small piece of data that are downloaded to your browser or device when you visit a certain web address, and can be recalled by a web server in the domain that placed the cookie. This data often consists of a string of numbers and letters that uniquely identifies your device, but it can contain other information as well. Some cookies are placed by third parties acting on our behalf.

Cookies can remain on your device for different periods of time. Some Cookies are “session” Cookies, meaning that they exist only while your browser or the application is open. These Cookies are deleted automatically once you close your browser or application. Other Cookies are called “persistent” Cookies. The length of time a persistent Cookie stays on your device varies from Cookie to Cookie. They can be used to recognize your device when you open and use the websites again.

#### (2) Web beacons

Some of our webpages contain electronic tags known as web beacons (such as pixel tags, clear GIFs, JavaScript, and local storage, also known as “tracking pixels”) that we use to help deliver cookies on our websites, count users who have visited those websites, and deliver co-branded products (if any). We also include web beacons or similar tracking technologies in our electronic communications to determine whether you open and act on them.

#### (3) Other similar tracking technologies

In addition to standard cookies and web beacons, our Services may also use other similar tracking technologies to store and read data files on your device. This is typically done to maintain your preferences or to improve speed and performance by storing certain files locally. But, like standard cookies, these tracking technologies can also store a unique identifier for your device, which can then track behavior.

#### (4) Third party cookies

Finally, our Services may contain standard cookies, web beacons or similar tracking technologies (collectively, “Cookies”) from third-party analytics providers, which help us compile aggregated statistics about the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns or other operations. These technologies enable the analytics providers to set or read their own cookies or other identifiers on your device, through which they can collect information about your use of our website and other Services, including your IP address, web browser, mobile network information, pages viewed, time spent on pages or in apps, links clicked and conversion information. However, we prohibit these analytics providers from using web beacons on our sites to collect or access information that directly identifies you (such as your name or email address).

## 2. Use of Cookies and similar tracking technologies

Cookies are widely used by website owners to make their websites operate, work more efficiently, and provide analytic information. We use Cookies for following purposes:

- (1) store and honor your preferences and settings;

- (3) evaluate and tailor our marketing communications so as to provide interest-based advertising;
- (4) combat fraud;
- (5) analyze how our Services perform;
- (6) generally improving the user experience; and
- (7) fulfill other legitimate purposes.

Where required, we obtain your consent prior to placing or using optional cookies that are not (i) strictly necessary to provide the website; or (ii) for the purpose of facilitating a communication. Please see the “How to Control or Delete Cookies” section below for more information.

## 3. What types of Cookies do we use and how do we use them?

### Strictly Necessary Cookies

These are necessary for the website or application to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They also can be set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, or where applicable, logging in

or filling in forms. You can set your browser or mobile device to block these cookies, but some parts of our Services may not work properly in that case.

cookieyes-consent	1 year	Cookieyes sets this cookie to remember users' consent preferences so that their preferences are respected on subsequent visits to this site. It does not collect or store any personal information about the site visitors.

### Functionality Cookies

These Cookies are used to recognize you when you return to our Sites. This enables us to personalize our content for you, greet you by name, and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

### Analytics Cookies

We keep information collected from Cookies for no longer than the maximum period permitted by law.
